## Possible opening of schools in June for more pupils

We are still waiting for further clarification from the government after last night's announcements and documentation, which will hopefully help us create an Action Plan for our phased reopening. We will share this with you as soon as possible so you know what the school's reopening will look like in practice.

I know it is a very unsettling time for us all, but rest assured that we are going to be doing everything we can to make sure we are ready to receive your children if it is safe for our school to reopen in the coming weeks. **This means safe for your children, the staff and yourselves on the school run.** 

However, we are also not going to be pressuring anyone to send their children to school, since you know your children and personal situation best. We will keep you updated with all our preparations for making sure the school is as safe as possible, so you can make an informed decision.

In the meantime, the school is still open **only** for vulnerable pupils and the children of critical workers. We know some employers will be encouraging you to return to work, but we are not in a position right now to extend places to other children until we receive further government guidance.

We would like to thank you for your continued support in helping your child learn from home. We will need to keep going with this for a while yet, so please do continue to do what you can and stay in touch with us about how your child is doing through Class Dojo.
