I surveyed the parents of Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 yesterday as these are the year groups judged by the Government to be in the first phase. Many thanks for the overwhelming response - nearly all parents responded.

Obviously I have to plan and risk assess for everyone returning but it does give an indication of the feeling of you all at the moment. I will pass your concerns on to the relevant authorities.

I will keep you updated with my plans as to how and when we could return and what this would look like for your child.

I also appreciate the difficulty of only sending one of your children back to school if your other children are not in the Year Groups that are being asked to return. None of this is easy to understand or plan for as you can imagine. It is also difficult if you are being asked to return to work yourselves without school being able to have your children in yet. This is not an easy situation at all and I am sorry. Hopefully we will turn a corner soon.
