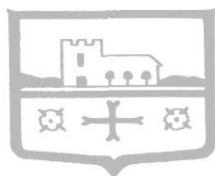


Parent/Carer

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- I must ensure everyone in my household keeps to all government instructions regarding social distancing at all times or my child cannot attend school
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family. I must then follow instructions given by the school as to what to do next
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately and follow the recommendation for a COVID-19 test;
- I will arrive on time when dropping off and picking up
- My child must only bring in items the school has allowed.
- I will check my child's temperature before attending school.
- I need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully
- I need to share and promote the good hygiene information with my child regularly
- I will not enter the school site and will communicate with the school by phone or email
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis;
- I must read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I will inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

COVID-19 Home School Agreement

I will do my best to:

- Keep to social distancing rules when I am not in school
- Leave plenty of space between me and people from other families as I come into school and am waiting to wash my hands or use the toilet;
- Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Only go in my room and allocated toilets
- Wash my hands when I arrive at school, before and after sharing resources or playing outside, after going to the toilet and before and after eating
- Follow good hygiene instructions
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.

The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Provide you with up to date, clear information about what measures we have in place in school to manage the risk
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's group show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in our school Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Provide good communication between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and the school website.
